#### **Before Exam**


Submit appendix 1 and appendix 2

- Aware that no appeal will be entertained for incorrect files o incomplete answer scripts after the exam




# What is asynchronous online exam?

- Lecturer sets the time for the exam
- Students download the exams questions from Blackboard
- The exam questions will be password protected
- Password will be given to students once the exam time starts
- Students then answer the exam questions offline. Internet connection is not required at this point. No online proctoring, no invigilation through web camera is needed.
- However there will be two times of answer submissions.
   Interim Submission and Final Submission.
- Additional 15 minutes extra times will be given for both submission.

- After 1 hour 30 minutes, Students must submit Interim Answer
- Once submitted, Students can continue answering their exam offline
- 15 minutes extra time is given

- Students upload th final answer when the exam ends.
- Must upload all answer again.
- 15 minutes extra til is given

#### Interim Submission

- -Students' answer sheet that has been done at the time after 1 hour 30 minutes answering the exam
- -Required by University during the online examination

### Final Submission

- -Students' final and formal answer sheet.
- -This submission is the one that will be graded by your lecturers.
- -Must be the complete answer sheet that you have done. Even though you have submitted partially during Interim submission, you still need to recompile and submit everything again
- -Must be in PDF format in single file document

# For Courses: Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Economics

(3 hours + 30 minutes extra time)

2.00 pm Students get password to open the exam questions from lecturer. Begin answering offline

3.30 - 3.45 pm Students scan their answer sheet and upload their Interim Submission

5.15 - 5.30 pm Students stop answer and begin Final Submission. Upload ALL answers

# For Courses: ICT, Business Mathematics (2 hours 30 minutes +30 minutes extra time)

### **IMPORTANT!**

### FAQ

### 1. Caught cheating during online examination

# 3. Students took longer time to submit answer than the allocated time (extra 15 minutes)

If students took longer than the given buffer time to submit their answer and did not inform lecturer within the given 15 minutes, lecturer can assume that students' problem is not genuine. Lecturer has the right to not accept students' late answer submission.

## FAQ(cont.)

### 4. Answer scripts file is too big

Contact lecturers, maybe can send via email/Google Drive or divide into two docs, and the worst case scenario send photos through WhatsApp

### 5. Student says they missed a page in uploading their answer script

If students inform lecturer within the given 15 minutes extra time during final submission, students could be allowed to resubmit their answers. However, if this issue arises after the 15 minutes extra time has ended, lecturer has the right to not accept students' resubmission
