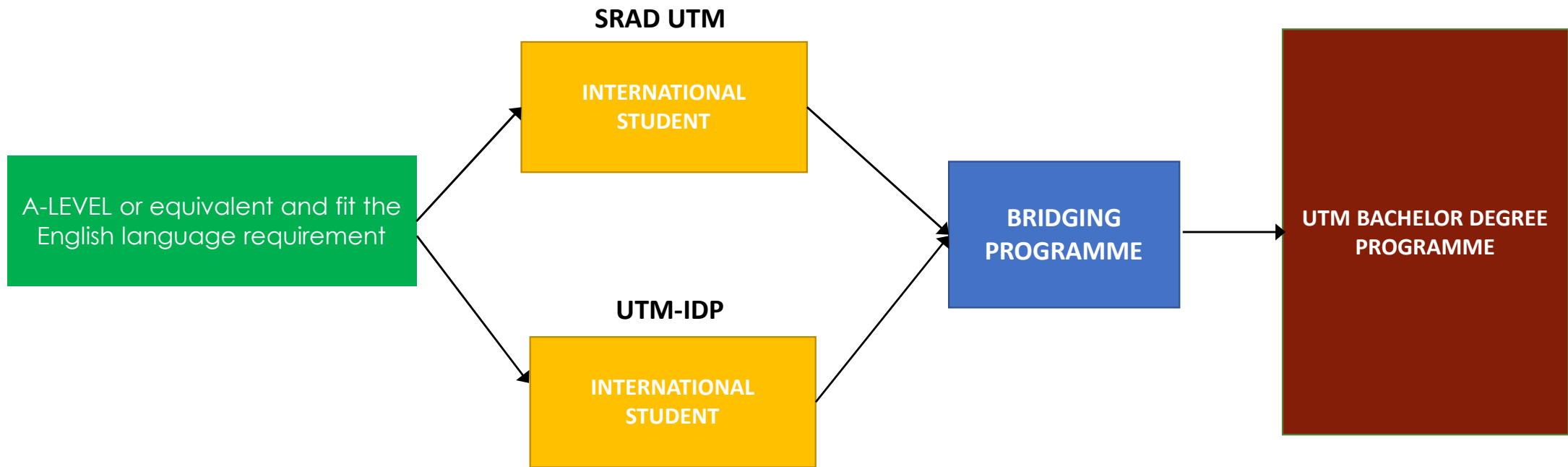

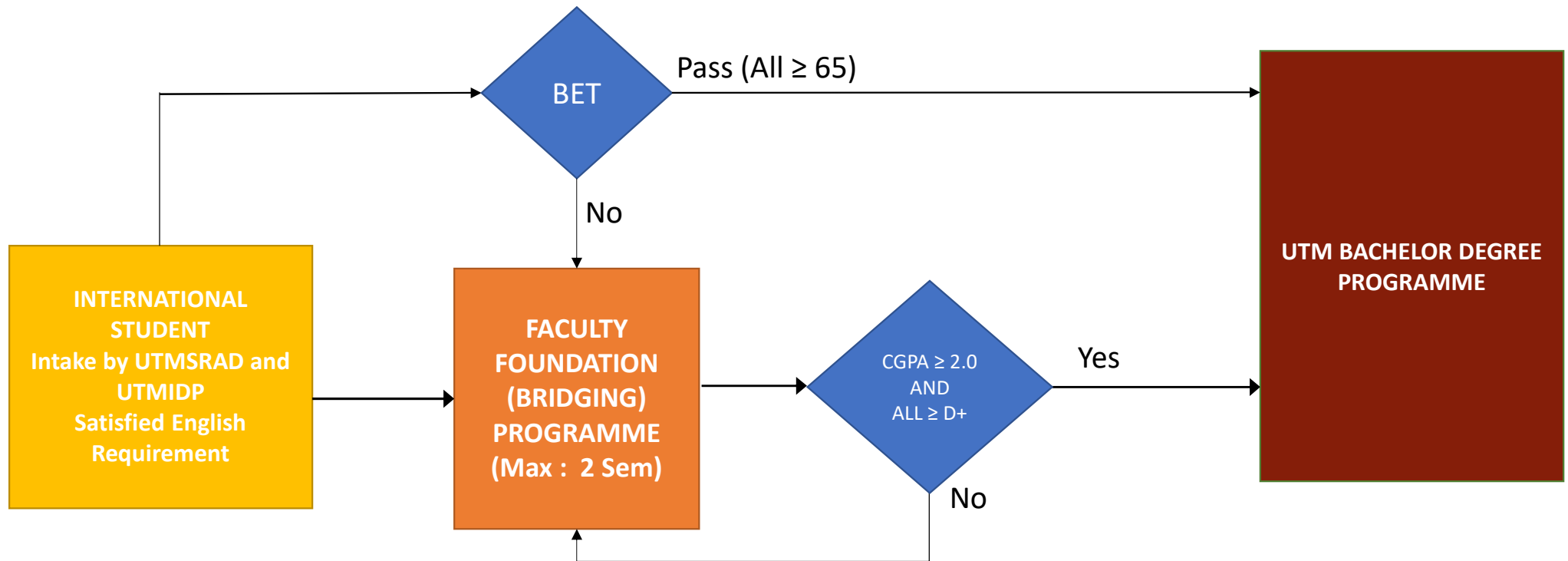
- Assessments - tests, quizzes, assignments and final examination throughout the semester.

- Students who take the BET Test and passed, can skip Bridging Programme and can register for the degree programme this semester
- Passing Marks : 65 % for all Courses according to Module
- Students who take the BET Test and failed, will need to continue for Bridging Programme
- Fee : RM 500.
- Due date for registration : 12th October 2021. End of day today.

 - For repeating students, insert only the courses that you failed in previous semester, or the courses you need to improve.
4. Submit the registration form online through the given link on item #3 in the registration kit website.

FAQ

1. What platform do we use for online learning?

You will use a platform called Blackboard for online learning. Refer to the Blackboard manual that we put on the registration kit website on how to use it.

2. When can we login to Blackboard account ?

We will try to create those who did the registration before 14th Oct, to have it by the end of week 1. Student who registered later than 14th Oct, will need to wait for another couple of days for their Blackboard account to be created. But you can still attend the lecture even without having a Blackboard account. Just click the link on the timetable.

3. Is the class is going to be online until the end of semester ?

Yes. The class will be online, and the final exam will be online as well.
